The focus of this exercise is leadership decision making and communications on the part of Division or Group Supervisors.

7. Message: <u>Provide Student Gen. Message of instructions and the CC HazMat I201 to each of the students and assign them to their Division or Group. When you are ready to start the Game provide them the following briefing:</u> At 0840 today a train wreck occurred west of Crescent City & there is fire and hazardous materials involved. Initial assessment was: 10 rail cars derailed at Wilson Crk bridge on west side of Crescent City. Cars 5-7 are extensively damaged and on fire. Car 5 had an initially unknown quantity of molten Sulphur. Car 6 has 12000 gallons of liquid phosphorus & car 7 has tallow. Other cars derailed/damaged/but with less hazardous cargo. IAIC directed police responders to evacuate residences & businesses on Soldiers Home Rd and establish perimeter on Soldiers Home Rd. between Sycamore St & Wilson Creek bridge. Crescent City/Barnstable County Hazmat is at rail cars 5-7. They report that the molten sulphur car is leaking and that the leak has gotten into Wilson Creek. No estimate of volume leak. Leak cannot be safely stopped at source. Phosphorus car is fully engaged with fire, and it could spread to other cars. Phosphorus car is not leaking/fire is consuming, smoke plume threatening downtown Crescent City. CCFD Engines on scene. The response was • Evacuate the immediate area around the crash site and to evacuate portions of downtown Crescent City east of the Crescent River & establish/maintain a perimeter. • Establish evac corridors that lead to High School & YMCA shelters. • Assess & contain the spill • Prevent extension of the fire and suppress the fire if possible to stop the hazardous smoke plume Further details of subsequent actions and assessments are in the ICS201. Overall guidance in the 201 indicates that the evacuation zone west of the River needs to expand to the North, that the evacuation zone east of the River in Downtown Crescent City also needs to expand further east and north. Embedded within this evacuation area is 60 bed hospital. The city is opening and managing 2 shelters out of the zone, but you may have to establish evacuation routes. Environment conditions: The weather forecast is today's weather forecast for Sandwich Mass. There is one exception.... <u>The Wind vector to be used for Today is WSW 5-10 MPH</u> Initial Action resources have only been on-site for 3 hours and they all had just started today's shift of normal work at 0700 hours and are available for the rest of the Operational Period. The Extended Action additional resources are all fresh resources. The Students now have 10 minutes to complete the assignments given on their Instructions 213.

7. Message: PLAY THE GAME - Facilitator review Objectives and ask each DIVS to describe Strategy(s) for meeting those Objectives in their assignment. Note strategy terms should be concise; "evacuate, establish/maintain perimeter, confine/suppress fire". <u>Keep them focused on Strategy ideas and do not allow them delve into Tactics.</u> - Facilitator ask each DIVS to describe where they would deploy resources and what their assignment instructions are to them. Place the Icons on the Sand Table where assignments are made. Ask each DIVS as they are describing to state who they would have consulted in making these assignments. Complete the process till all Icons are placed on the table. <u>(DO NOT bring up Span of Control, additional line overhead needs or lack of LE resources at this point unless Students describe it as a problem. If they do, discuss possible solutions immediately)</u> - Did any DIVS identify lack of LE Tactical resources? If not initiate discussion on problem and solutions. - If Span of Control was not raised initiate the conversation with either DIVA or DIVB or both (could even simulate radio call to both DIVS A&B, identify problem and request suggestions for solutions).

Message: <u>ADDITIONAL INFORMATION FOR FACILITATOR ONLY</u> Facilitator Information: The following is not information on the ICS201 the DIVS Students have.... - There is a distinct shortage of LE units in at least DIV B for doing evacuations. What actually happened was that with the T3 Crowd Control Team order being filled EOC figured all the LE resource needs were covered and they had not been asked by IAIC Wilkins to order more. <u>DIV B should identify lack of assigned LE resources & come up with ways to fix it. That could initially include maybe asking to have the Patrol Car Strike Team reassigned to DIV B</u> - OSC noticed that they were light on LE resources and unbeknownst to DIVS placed an order for additional 10 LE patrol cars that was quickly filled by EOC. These units are presently checked in, have been briefed and are in Oak Street Staging awaiting assignment. <u>DIVS who need more LE should request STAM for them if permitted to go direct to STAM, or discuss/request through OSC.</u> - OSC also figured out just looking at the 201 that both DIVS (not Groups) were terribly outside of Span of Control. Before going to SPUL to order some he stopped by the RESL and inquired whether any checked in resources currently assigned were qualified TFLD or STLD. RESL advised there was 2 qualified TFLD assigned in DIVA, 1 on E104 and 1 on E207 and that the officers in CCPD cars 5,7 & 14 in the Perimeter Group were also fully qualified TFLD's. Because he has been involved with additional in-briefing actions and the Initial Strategy & Info Sharing Meeting with the C&G and has not be able to pass that info on to DIVS/GRPS yet <u>DIVS who need additional line overhead should figure out several ways to get it including talking with STAM other DIVS &/or OSC to reassign/OSC does need to be in contact even during meetings or have a Deputy to handle issues during meetings.</u> - OSC also ordered 3 additional TFLD's thru Supply and was notified by RESL that at 1320 those orders were filled and would arrive by 1340 for checkin. 1350 they checked in at ICP and were sent to OSC for inbriefing which was completed by 1400. OSC sent them to Oak St Staging to await further orders. <u>DIVS who need additional line overhead should figure out several ways to get it including talking with STAM other DIVS &/or OPS to reassign</u> - OSC finally called DIVS A&B to advise them that 3 TFLD's were available at Oak Street Staging.

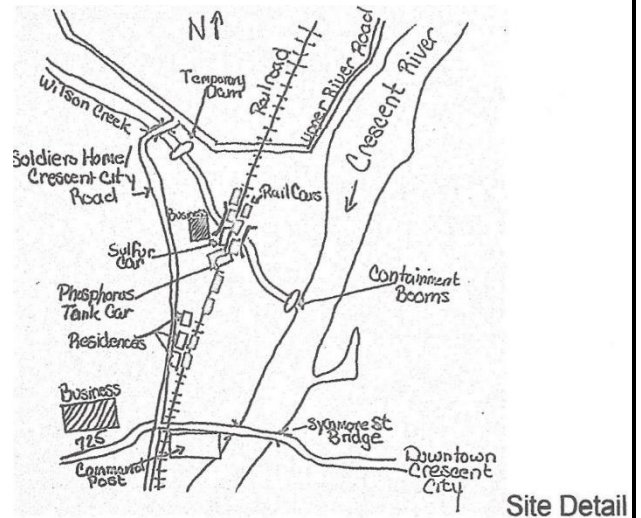
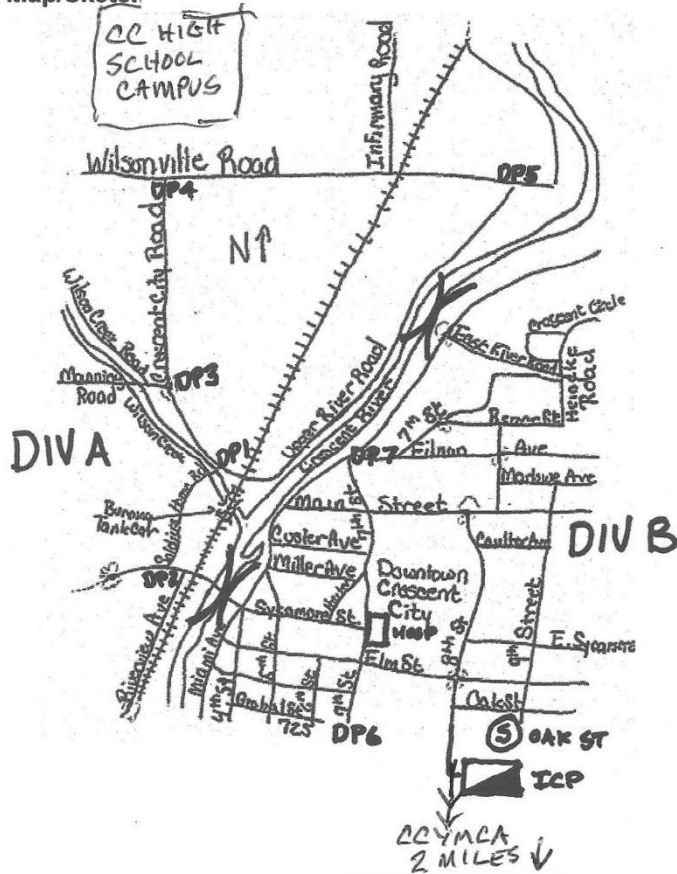

7. Message: - The Crescent City HazMat incident has just transitioned from ICT4 to management of an IMT3. You are DIVS on this IMT3 that has just arrived to take over Command of the incident. Your IMT is presently working through the stem of the Planning P having completed the in-briefings. For this exercise you will be assigned as the DIVS or Group Supervisor of DIV A or B, the Perimeter Group, the Monitoring Group or the Medical Services Group & OPS has sent you out to size up your assigned area, assess resource suitability & make/adjust current work assignments. - As DIVS you will need to size up your assignment and assign resources immediately with little direction from the Operations Section Chief. It is your job to direct the current Initial Action and additional Extended Action resources that are on scene. This is common in rapidly expanding incidents during early transfer of command. - The outgoing IAIC has prepared a detailed ICS201 that includes a considerable amount of information, including the IMT3 organization chart. The IC on your IMT3 has validated the objectives in the 201 for the current operational period that you are managing. <u>YOUR ASSIGNMENT IN THIS EXERCISE:</u> - Review objectives and select Strategies that would meet those objectives for your DIV/Group. - Determine tactical resource assignments for the resources assigned to you on the 201. - Determine immediate resource shortages or excesses & determine what to do about them. - Prepare for your participation in the Game that will run real time. You have 10 minutes to make these determinations then the Game will begin. The facilitator will begin by reviewing the Objectives, ask each DIVS what Strategy(s) they would employ for their Division/Group, then ask questions about their tactical assignment decisions while moving the icons to visually depict the assignments. The Facilitator will then follow up with other questions to the Division and Group Supervisors that may include both fundamental questions and "what if" problems the DIVS might encounter.

5. Situation Summary and Health and Safety Briefing:

1100 Update: The Phosphorus car continues to burn and cannot be extinguished. Strategy is to confine & allow to burn out. The Molten Sulfur car has 15000 gallons, estimated 1000 gal have leaked into Wilson Creek and soil at crash site. Strategy is to confine the spill to Wilson Creek. The plume is being driven to the east into CC proper, and the evacuation zone needs to be extended east to at least 8th St and east end of E. River Road. ARC has opened two shelters outside of threat zone. There have been reports of some small boats using the Crescent River.

Updates/Division:

DIVA-Evacuations completed from Sycamore St Bridge, up Soldiers Home Rd to Wilson Creek Bridge. Haz-Mat engaged at crash site but cannot presently stop leak from Sulfur tankcar. Starting to dike, but need help to dike and boom Wilson Creek. Engines successfully engaged in confining fire spread using master stream. Phosphorus car will continue to burn for many hours. Will need additional resources to extend closure further north if desired. One minor injury (trip/bruise) to HazMat team member.

DIVB-Evacuation completed north of Sycamore & west of 7th between DP6&7. Additional resources will be needed to expand the evac to the east. The 60 bed hospital at the NE corner of Sycamore and 7th St. needs to be evacuated and there are 8 patients that will need ALS xport, 12 needing BLS xport, 16 more ambulatory.

Winds shifted to WSW 5-10 mph ALL OTHER WEATHER PARAMETERS ARE 9/20/17 FORECAST FOR SANDWICH, MASS.

Current and Planned Objectives: 1-Continually ensure the safety of the public and incident personnel by following appropriate agency guidelines, utilizing a risk assessment and mitigation process prior to engagement, and conducting an orderly evacuation of potentially impacted areas that is coordinated with cooperators and the media. 2-Evacuate public, stakeholders and special needs populations from areas that are threatened by the hazmat plume prior to them being exposed to hazardous airborne materials and maintain this perimeter until monitoring determines it is safe to re-occupy. 3-Continue to confine further spread of the fire and extinguish the fire when technically and safely feasible. 4-Prevent hazardous materials from spreading into Crescent River and confine soil contamination to areas presently contaminated. 5-Provide accurate and timely information to town and county government, the public, cooperating agencies and stakeholders.

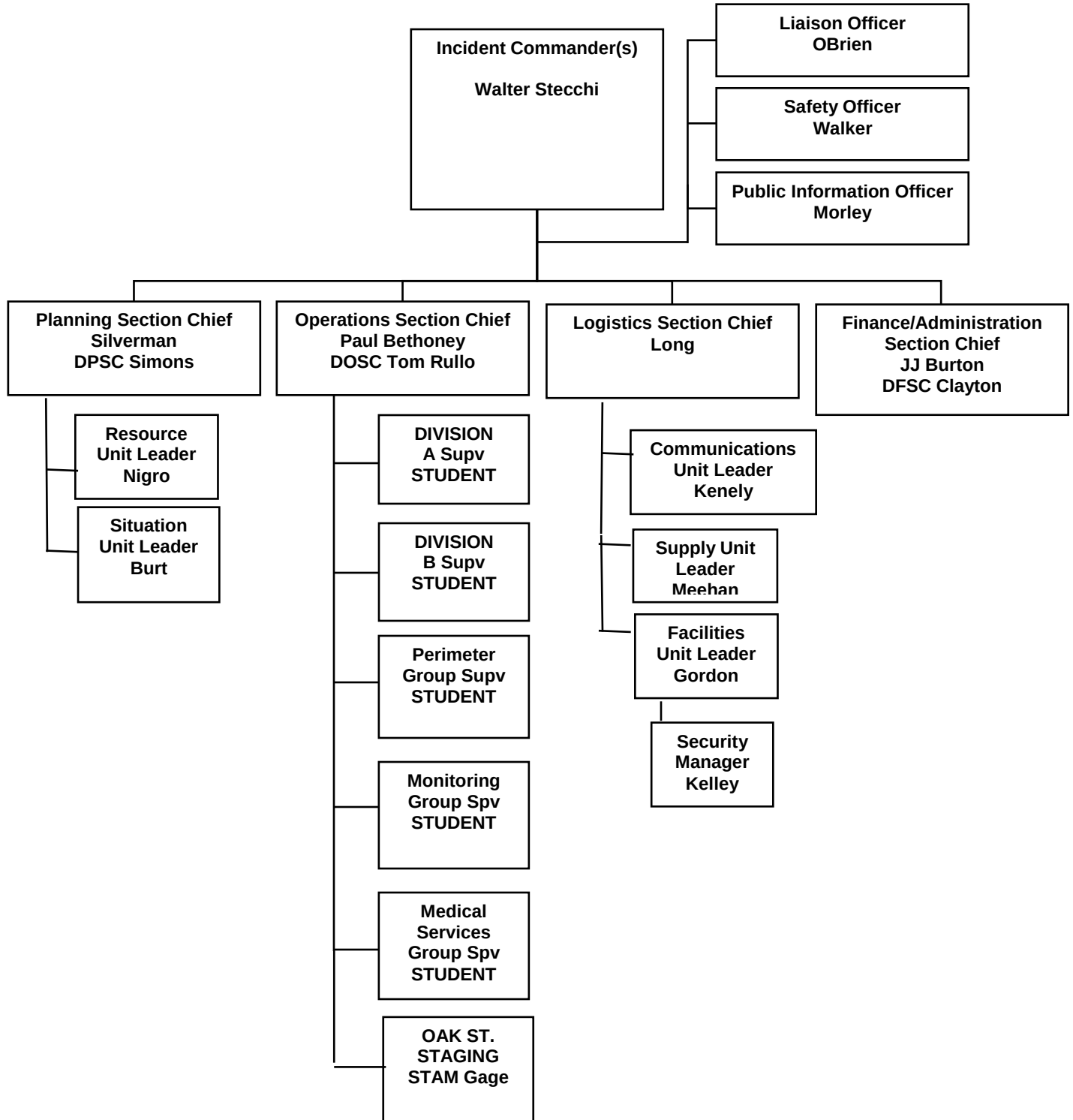
